My beloved brethren,

Greetings to you all in Jesus name. I appreciate you all for your love, prayers and assistance in one way or the other. It is a great sacrifice you have made in a difficult time like this to contribute your hard end money for the work of Christ in Nigeria and Cameroon. Each day, your love and sacrifice opens a new page of challenge in our lives. The great of this challenge is to love God with all our heart and remain faithful to Him all that we do. May God help to this end in Jesus name.

During last month, we I spent much of time with Mazah congregation. The Devil is trying to side track some members. Apart from the problem of wrong teaching that inroaded into the Church, some brethren are having family issues that make them very sad. One of them told me that he is not interested in his marriage again. Brethren, this gives me alot of concern. But after talking with his wife, things are getting much better, and there is more hope that things will work out. The other brother his wife does not differentiate between the Church and denomination. I have scheduled a study with the entire family this coming Saturday by the grace of God. Please, keep all of these in prayers. One thing that happens here is trying to bring more, and keeping the saved save. The Church at Toro is also passing through difficult time as some of them are coming face to face with the truth of God's word. Some of them had poor marriage history. Now they are learning marriage from the Bible and it differs from what the tradition teaches. Some of them have to make tough decision to remain for God.

About a week from today, we will be moving for a three day evangelism campaign at Bokkos. This is planned by our congregation in Jos. Our hopes are high, we are working hard to put things in their places. Please, pray for us. One of the brothers at Old Foron congregation, who had stopped worship for some time because of their family problem resumed worship. We are hoping that with his coming back, God will help us resolve the problem that lead to his backsliding. The New congregation is moving on well. One of the members there is on training right now at the SBS, Jos. I hope when he graduates, some of my load will reduce, or my focus will change to another place.

Fuel crises has returned to Nigeria. Right now we can't see fuel. The available one is sold for \$1 dollar for a litre. That is \$5 for a gallon. This has increase the suffering and prices of things have changed upward. Please, keep praying for us. Without your help, it would have been tough. May God keep blessing you in every good way. Sandra lost her step brother, and the burial is coming up this month. Please, have in prayers as she will travel over 700 miles to attend the funeral.
