Dreams come true with God. For the longest time, I prayed to God, that He would allow me to visit my father's country one last time before leaving this earth. As John Black and his wife visited us, I shared this dream of mine. At first he did not say anything about it, but the next morning he came into my office and said " Roland if you want to visit us in Yemen, your father's country I will pay your trip and if Rose wants to come along with you I will also pay for her". I first could not believe it, and I was so emotional that after he left my office I cried with joy and thanked God for John and his wife making it possible for me to realise this dream.

At first, Rose was not sure if she wanted to make the trip with me, but thank God she finally decided to come along, for which I was very glad. We left Paris on the 20th for a ten day trip and were back in Paris on Saturday 31st in the evening. Visiting all the places I had been 42 years



ago, it was wonderful, and I even was able to meet my nephew and several of my cousins for which it was the first time for most of them. I came back filled with good memories.

Upon our return from the trip, we heard the good news that 2 precious souls were added to the kingdom, Didier Caloc the son of Victor and Paquerette Caloc, so now the only one who has not yet obeyed in this family is Victor the father, but let me tell the good news, the Sunday before we left for our trip he came to me and said, "Roland when you come back, I would like to talk to you about being baptized."

The other baptism is one of the contacts I had studied with while in Cameroon. A woman that Simon continued to study with and she obeyed. God just ask us to sow the seed of His word.

Alexandre Haugel from Rouen who came and stayed in our home for the New Year's party, stays in contact with me regularly and I talk to him and send him regularly Bible studies through email and Skype. He expressed the fact that he would like to start something in Rouen on a regular bases , and we have one family that lives only about 40 miles from Rouen and therefore we will see if we can begin something in that city, so please pray about this project.

2009 is the year that we are making our furlough trip. I have not started our itinerary but I will do my best to have it ready for the end February or the latest for the month of March.

With the way it is all over the world, with the economy and with thousands of people losing their jobs, in regard to our support we already have lost more than \$1000 in monthly support, but we are trusting God that we will be able to make up for it during our trip this summer.

We are always thankful unto God and for all of you that have been behind us for all these years. May God continue to richly bless each and every one of you.

Good morning brother Holloway,

Greetings to you, mom, dad, and the Church. I am sorry that I was unable to send a message of love and appreciation to you all on the Val day. I was very sick. I felt that I was going to die. But the grace of God has been so great that I am still alive. The sickness that started in mild form on Wednesday became serious on Thursday.

On Friday, it was difficult for me to move. On Saturday, I went to hospital, the Doctor suspected malaria and typhoid, but could not perform any test because there was no power. He treated me by faith. Well, am much better today, but am still leaving for the hospital for the test. Last night, I got a call from my sister in the

village that my dad is very sick again. Right now he can not eat and cannot talk. If am better, I will leave tomorrow to see him. Please, do remember us in your prayers. Even though it comes after the Valentine, know that you all so special to me and my family. Have a great day.

Good morning my dear brother,

Thanks for your prayers. I have received this morning some mails from brethren expressing their concern and prayers for my father and I recovery. The Lord is at work brother. I will take time to appreciate all of them for the mails. There were so encouraging. I have not been able to check mails for some days now.

Unfortunately, I was unable to travel down to see my father due to the fact that I have been very weak. The treatment of malaria and typhoid at the same time leaves almost devastated than the sicknesses. I thank God because I gaining more strength. I went back for medical check up, it was confirmed that the malaria is still there. I am still on the drugs anywhere. Besides, my senior brother called me not to bother coming as he was doing his part to see that my father receives treatment. As at yesterday, I was able to communicate by phone with my father. He told me that he is getting better, even though he was asked to be in the hospital today to see the medical experts. I am optimistic that he will recover.

However, we continue asking God for his will at this moment. My father specifically told me not worry as he will be fine by the grace of God. I know this would have been possible if not for the prayers of the saints. Thanks so much brother. My regards to everyone.
